CAMPUS & LOCATION:



The school is known for its sprawling campus. It is 2.5 kms from the main town. It provides a serene and child-friendly environment. The board of management consists of educators and noted citizens of the area. TRPS is set in a salubrious and pristine ambience of 27 acres, a co-ed day-cum-residential school, 180 km South of state capital on the outskirts of Kokrajhar on Dotma Road. The school has been making statements with its dynamic, vibrant, noble, classic approach to education and state-of-the-art facilities for holistic development of every student. Here efforts are directed towards preparing students ahead of their times. Our responsibility lies not only in the development of academic skills, but also vital non cognitive skills. We foster adaptability, resilience and courage amongst students. They are groomed to rise and meet challenges of future and contribute to the world in which they live.

Located in the greenbelt of Kokrajhar -BTC, *The Reality Public School* (TRPS) is situated at Chandamari. The nearest **Railway station** is Kokrajhar (3.5 kms), the nearest **Airport** is at Rupshi, Kokrajhar (70 kms).

From Guwahati : 212 kms. Follow the NH 31C- road upto Karigaon Junction and then turn left towards Kokrajhar. The entrance to the Dotma Road is 24 kms down this road on the right hand side. Rail distance is 178 kms and all trains from Guwahati to NJP pass through Kokrajhar.

From Siliguri : 190 kms. Follow the NH-31C Guwahati road up to Karigaon Junction and then turn right towards Kokrajhar. The entrance to Dotma Road is 24 kms down this road on the right hand side after petrol station.

From Bongaigaon : 50 kms. Follow the NH-31C to Siliguri and turn left at Karigaon trijunction.

THE JUNIOR SECTION:



The Junior Section comprises of classes from Nursery to Class III. The preschool nurtures three different groups Nursery, LKG and UKG where the children get individual care and attention for their all round development. The school curriculum aims at catching up the changing demands where emphasis is given on experimental learning. The teachers use various teaching aids to impart knowledge through ways and means that the children enjoy. Indoor and outdoor activities are planned for their growth and fine motor development. Effective learning takes place in play-way method. The students are nurtured in such an environment that they become more receptive and eager to learn. The focus lies on teaching the students through experiential learning. The classroom ambience nourishes and stimulates their imagination for interactive participation.



TRPS has a perfect blend of natural surroundings and modern architecture, offering the children lush green peaceful and eco-friendly stay. The school has large playground and track & field ground. A separate hostel facility for girls & boys with 2 stand-by Generator sets for an uninterrupted power supply.

CLASS STRUCTURE & SUBJECTS:

The following combination of subjects are offered in the Senior Secondary level (Class XI & XII) in Science and Humanities (Arts)

Science : English, Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Biology, Computer Science & Physical Education.

Humanities (Arts) : English, Pol. Science, History, Geography, Economics, Sociology, Psychology & Physical Education.

Pre-School (Nursery, LKG & UKG) : English, Maths, EVS, Hindi, Handwriting, Art, Rhymes, Dance, Music, Games & Swimming.

EIGHT TEACHING PERIODS PER DAY.

Classes I & II : English, Maths, EVS, Hindi, MIL (Bodo/Assamese)

All students from I to V study Moral Science, GK, Art, Handwriting, Computer, Library, Dance, Music & Swimming.

Classes III to VIII : English, Maths, Social Science, Science, Hindi, MIL (Bodo/ Assamese)

All students from VI to VIII study Computer, Library, Dance, Music & Swimming.

Classes IX & X : English, Maths, Social Science, Science, Hindi / Bodo / Assamese.

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT:

Shaping Minds through interactive participation, TRPS campus is Wi-Fi enabled to promote IT-Based teaching / learning culture. Classrooms are equipped with digital smart boards where learning becomes fun. The students are nurtured in such an environment that they become more receptive and eager to learn. The focus lies on teaching the students through experiential learning. The classroom ambience nourishes and stimulates their imagination for interactive participation. All classrooms are spacious, well-ventilated and scientifically designed.

The school promotes 'hands-on experience' on computers from class I onwards. Department of Information Technology in TRPS is well equipped with 2 computer labs. One lab equipped with 40 computers and another with N computing equipped with 48 consoles. The labs have online Mathematics programmes like 'Mind Spark' (for Classes IV-VII) and 'First in Math' (for Classes IV -VIII) to create interest of the students in Mathematics. The school is also in the process of embracing Technology by providing Apple Laptops to all the students as a Teaching-Learning tool in the technological area. All the systems are well connected with Internet (Wired and Wi-Fi) with high speed of 100 MBPS and local network. Both labs are equipped with projector and smart board systems to deliver lectures through multimedia in order to enhance the teaching- learning process to move beyond the confines of the classrooms.

HOW WE WORK

Students are taught by subjects specialists.

Each teacher is specifically trained to teach their subject, and we have good mixture of local teachers and expatriate staff. Our classrooms have dynamic spaces where students can work in groups, pairs and individually. They are encouraged to show their learning in different ways-not just with tests and quizzes, but through presentations, peer assessment and demonstrations to name but a few.

ADMISSION

The new academic session begins in early April every year. The school offers admissions from Pre-School to IX and XI, irrespective of social status, religion or nationality, subject to the availability of seats. The lower age limit for admission in Class I in the school is 6 years as on 1st April of the year of joining the school. Similarly, correlation of age and class to which admission is sought is an essential requirement. In Class XI admission is on the basis of Board Examination results and Aptitude Assessment Test (AAT) to be held in the Months of February, March and April, subject to further making mark as per the AAT Merit List.

The admission process involves a Registration cum Aptitude Test and completion of the related formalities as specified in subsequent paragraphs. The admission of a child will mean a complete acceptance by the parent /guardian of all school rules as in force or as amended from time to time at the discretion of the school. The school fully reserves the right of admission and its decision in the matter is final and binding and cannot be questioned. The school reserves the right to change its admission procedure from time to time.

THE ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

The Reality Public School is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The medium of education is English. Teaching is centered around the learner and is activity based with the use of CD ROMS, Audio Visual Aids and a lot of project work. In order to ensure the meaningful learning in pre-primary and early primary levels, the teachers use the activity-based teaching learning commonly known as 'Play-Way' method. Evaluation is continuous and takes into account all the work done by the child during the term. Students are also assessed through weekly tests on Saturdays. Examinations are held according to latest CBSE norms and guidelines.

Tutorial classes are held for the students of the hostel who require extra help in addition to the classroom teachings. Workshops, seminars and orientation programmes are held for the students at regular intervals by experts invited from outside, to enhance their academic interests and values of life. Educational trips and nature trails, excursions and participation in co-curricular activities make the educational programme a stimulating experience. Value education and Life Skills are incorporated into the curriculum to offer a holistic approach to education.



PROCESS OF ADMISSION:

Registration forms along with the prospectus for Classes Nursery to IX & XI are available in the School Office and can be obtained on any working day between 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM. Parents may collect the Registration Form from the school counter by paying Rs. 2000/- or by post by sending a bank draft of Rs. 2000/- within India or by paying online in school A/c in favour of the 'The Reality Public School', payable at Kokrajhar. The payment may be disbursed through net also in school's bank account and by sending a due confirmation through e-mail with relevant particulars of the child including the date of birth. The registration fee is neither refundable nor adjustable and is valid only for the specified academic year. Registrations for admissions are held in the month of November to February at the school premises. The Registration and Aptitude Assessment Test (AAT) is conducted only at the school premises. Completed Registration Forms should be sent by courier/ speed post / by hand.

Post Registration, the applicant is required to appear in the AAT at the school on a specified date. The AAT assesses the Literacy, Numeracy and Scientific Skills of the candidate followed by an interactive session. Results of AAT are uploaded on the school website/ notice board within a week after the test. Registration for Class-XI students are opened in the month of January to March for the forthcoming academic session. In the absence of class X results, candidates may be provided provisional admission. Aptitude Assessment Test for provisional admission to class-XI takes place in the months of February/March. Provisional Classes will start in the 1st week of April. A student who has been offered a provisional admission must subsequently obtain the required grades in class-X Board Examinations for continuance in the school.

Procedure:

All registrations are done for a particular year and for the class requested for by the parent. If a parent wishes to re-register the student a fresh registration form is required to be filled with disbursement of due fee. Registration of a student is not a guarantee of her/his admission.



REQUIREMENT OF DOCUMENTS AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION :-

Two recent passport size photographs of the applicant.

Duly-filled Registration form, Self attested photocopy of the student's Birth Certificate. (The Birth Certificate should be the one issued by the Registrar of Birth and Deaths of the area in which the child was born.) Affidavits, Certificates from the hostel, or certificates from any other person are not accepted.

ADMISSION FORMALITIES

Students who made the grade for the admission in The Reality Public School must pay the 1st installment of the annual school fee and complete all admission formalities within 10 days after declaration of AAT results. If payment of the fee has not been made by the stipulated date, the school reserves the right to withdraw the offer of admission.

The following documents are required to be submitted at the time of reporting of the student in the school:-

Birth Certificate: Self attested photocopy of date of birth certificate issued by the Registrar of the Birth and Death. The date of birth informed / submitted at time of admission shall be final and no request for change of birth date shall be entertained under any circumstances by the school. Misrepresentation or falsification of date of birth will result in cancellation of admission forthwith.

Transfer Certificate and Character Certificate (Original) : Transfer Certificate from the school last attended, issued by the Principal immediately prior to the student joining TRPS or Original Transfer Certificate duly countersigned by the District Education Officer in respect of students coming from other recognized/private school.

Mark-sheet / Report card (Attested Photocopy) : The student is required to submit the Report Card /mark-sheet of previous class, indicating promotion to the next class, as well as proof of attendance for the previous year.

Passport Size Photograph : Two photos of mother ,father ,persons authorized by the parents to meet their ward (for Identity card purpose). The parents can obtain maximum five Identity Cards from the school-office for themselves and other members of the family, who may be allowed to meet the student. Only authorized persons/Identity Card holders are allowed to meet the student in the school and take the student out for outward and homeward journey etc.

Medical Certificate : All new entrants are required to produce a medical certificate certifying that they are free from any contagious or infectious disease and are otherwise physically fit to be admitted to a residential school. The parents must give an undertaking in writing to this effect. If the girl/boy is found medically unfit, the admission stands cancelled.

Photographs : Six recent passport size photographs are required to be submitted by each new student. Migration Certificate (Original): This is required for admission to Class XI in the case of students from different State Boards other than CBSE.

Attested Photocopy : Attested photocopy of the certificate of School-Based Evaluation in respect of students admitted in Class-XI coming from schools affiliated to CBSE. Aadhaar Card & Pan Card : Photocopy of Aadhaar Card of the student and copy of Pan Card of the parents.

Email ID & Contact : Email ID and Contact No. with the correspondence address on the separate plain paper.

Note : Until the Transfer Certificate and other documents are received by TRPS, the student's admission is considered as provisional.

WITHDRAWAL PROCESS

Students may be withdrawn from the school at the end of the academic year . Parents are requested to give intended withdrawal notice to the Principal before 15th March. The Transfer Certificate will be issued to the student within 20 days from the date of submission for withdrawal after clearance of all dues from the different departments. Request for withdrawal during the mid academic session should be forwarded to the Principal at least one month in advance.



REPORTING LATE AFTER VACATION OR BREAK

If students return late after the break / vacations or do not attend the school because of illness or any other reason without prior sanction, in writing, from the Principal, a sum of Rs. 1000/- per day will be charged as a penalty for 15 days, after that name of the child will be struck off the school roll and full admission fee of Rs. 10,000/- shall be charged in case continuance in the school is desired.

MODE OF FEE-REMITTANCE

The School made it convenient for all parents to deposit fee on-line at their hometown. The banks through which payment of fees can be made are shown here below.



DUPLICATE TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

On Demand of issue of Duplicate Transfer Certificate, Rs. 500/- (Rs.Five Hundred) will be charged from the student and it will be issued within a week. Money can be paid online/by cash /by demand draft in favour of The Reality Public school -Kokrajhar or in school A/c No. and details of the transaction will be intimated to the school . If transfer certificate is required in emergency within a day Rs.1500/- (Rs. Fifteen Hundred) will be charged from the student .

PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES & OTHER CHARGES

The School Fee would be collected in four parts as per the detail given in the fee structure. Parents are requested to read all the details given in the fee structure carefully. School authorities take no responsibility for sending separate intimation every time. Parents/ Guardians are advised to make remittances within the due dates, on their own. The total fee is payable in advance. A late fee fine, as applicable is charged in case fee is not paid by the due date. Parents have the option to deposit fees in advance.

COURSE OF STUDY - SYLLABI

The Reality Public School follow the syllabi of Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi. For the Class X CBSE

Examinations the school is able to offer a wide choice of discipline options . Apart from the compulsory subjects which include English, Hindi, Social Science, Mathematics and Science students are required to select at least one skill-based subject for the Board Examinations.

The choice includes Computer Applications, Yoga, Kathak, Bharatnatyam, Vocal Music, Instrumental Music and Art.



FACULTY AND FACULTY - TRAINING

The Reality Public School follow the syllabi of Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi. For the Class X CBSE

Examinations the school is able to offer a wide choice of discipline options . Apart from the compulsory subjects which include English, Hindi, Social Science, Mathematics and Science students are required to select at least one skill-based subject for the Board Examinations.

PARENT-TEACHER MEETINGS

Regular Parent Teacher Interactions (PTI) are held in the school after every term wherein the parents and respective teachers discuss the overall mental, physical and psychological growth of the child through a well planned grading system and subject wise / competency-wise report card.



COACHING

Increasingly, technical universities and colleges are making it more challenging for the students to get admission. Students have the challenges not only to master the contents but also have to apply it experimentally through practice that involves a specialized approach. The school has provisions for coaching for IIT / Engineering and Medical Entrance Exams. Our students are sure to excel and get admission in Engineering and Medical Colleges in near future.



SPORTS AND PHYSICAL TRAINING



The school has two Football grounds, three Volleyball courts, two Basketball courts, five Badminton courts, a Lawn Tennis court and two swimming pools. Physical training is imparted keeping in mind the healthy development of body and mind. Well trained faculty and expert coaches are at hand to guide and encourage the students for different sports activities. Over the years the students have represented the school in various District and National Level Sport events conducted by CBSE.



The most popular of all the sports is the Football. Various camps are organized at regular intervals where trainers from India and abroad are invited to train the students and develop their knowledge and skills in sporting activities.



SCHOOL FACILITIES

A fleet of school buses provide 'home pick-up' and drop under the care of school security staff. School provides transportation facilities to the students from Nursery to Class IX, from various parts of Kokrajhar town. The drivers and bus security staff provide extra care during journey.



Learning beyond the Classroom: CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

The Reality Public School has four houses- Chakrashila, Orang, Kaziranga and Manas. All the students are distributed into these four houses. The Inter house and Inter - School games, from time to time, build up a healthy competitive spirit as well as team work among the children. The academic competitions such as Elocution, Debate, Extempore speech, Skit, Story Narration, Recitation etc. develop the skill of articulation and creativity among the students. Along with these other competitions such as Creative Writing, Poem Composing, Story Writing, Quiz, Dance, One act play and Mono acting also stimulate the talent of the child. All the children are given ample opportunities to bring out their hidden talents in various co-curricular activities.



STUDENTS' COUNCIL

The Reality Public School selects its new council members among the students every year. These members are selected on the basis of their academic performance and their overall conduct. The names of such students from Classes IX and XI are first short listed. Every teacher then votes them as per their individual choice based on their presentation on selection day. These votes are then calculated and as per their descending order and portfolios are allotted to the Head Boy and the Head Girl and are selected from Class XI while all other members of the council including those of the Prefectorial Board are selected from Classes IX and XI.



FOOD & BEVERAGE

Girls and Boys are given a well-balanced nutritious diet, both vegetarian and non-vegetarian, in separate dining halls. The meals are prepared and served under well trained chefs and bearers. The Tuck Shop also provides the hostel students the opportunity to buy tuck for a specified amount.



MONTHLY PARENT VISITS

(Sunday Afternoon)

On Sundays as earmarked in the school almanac, the parents of students are invited to visit their child on the campus. Such visits are generally held in between 1.00 PM & 5.00 PM and parents are permitted to bring Home Lunch for their child / ward on the campus on the condition that no plastic or garbage is left behind on the Campus. The parents could also interact with the members of the School Administrative Team on any issues pertaining to the child. During these visits parents are also permitted to scrutinize the student's academic work.





HOSTEL ACTIVITIES AND RECREATION

Pastoral care is the heart and soul of a residential school; at TRPS we call it a home away from home for our girls and boys. The Saoti Brahma Hostel hold around 135 girls under the supervision of able House Mistresses and Lady Wardens and adequate number of full time support staff. Similarly R. R. Brahma Boys Hostels hold 240 boys. Mentors to mentee ratio of 1:10 ensures holistic involvement in grooming, and gives a student the sense of belonging, mental and spiritual assurance of well-being and self reliance. Each house is equipped with all the basic amenities: including 24x7 power back up and water supply, centralized cooling, solar water heating system, refrigerated drinking water, conducive projection and recreation rooms, mini library and study rooms. Weekly phone call facility through cell phone for each child, helps to maintain a healthy connection of the child with their family members.

The hostel also has its own Council of Members, chosen on the basis of their conduct and leadership abilities. The members represent their fellow mates and help the hostel staff in the smooth functioning of the hostel.

Outdoor excursions and educational tours are organized for boarders once a year to different places of India and abroad to expose them into the diverse cultures and natural heritage of the places.

OTHER FACILITIES FOR THE STUDENTS INCLUDING HOSTELLERS

The boarders get proper guidance and counselling from the school counsellor, subject teachers and the house wardens. They supplement their free time by reading current magazines and newspapers. Films are screened once a week and the hostel common room is also equipped with a music system, television, VCD player and DTH cable connection. There is a fully automated laundry and a store with books & stationery items to meet the student's daily needs. Every child is provided with a study-unit and Kurlon mattress.

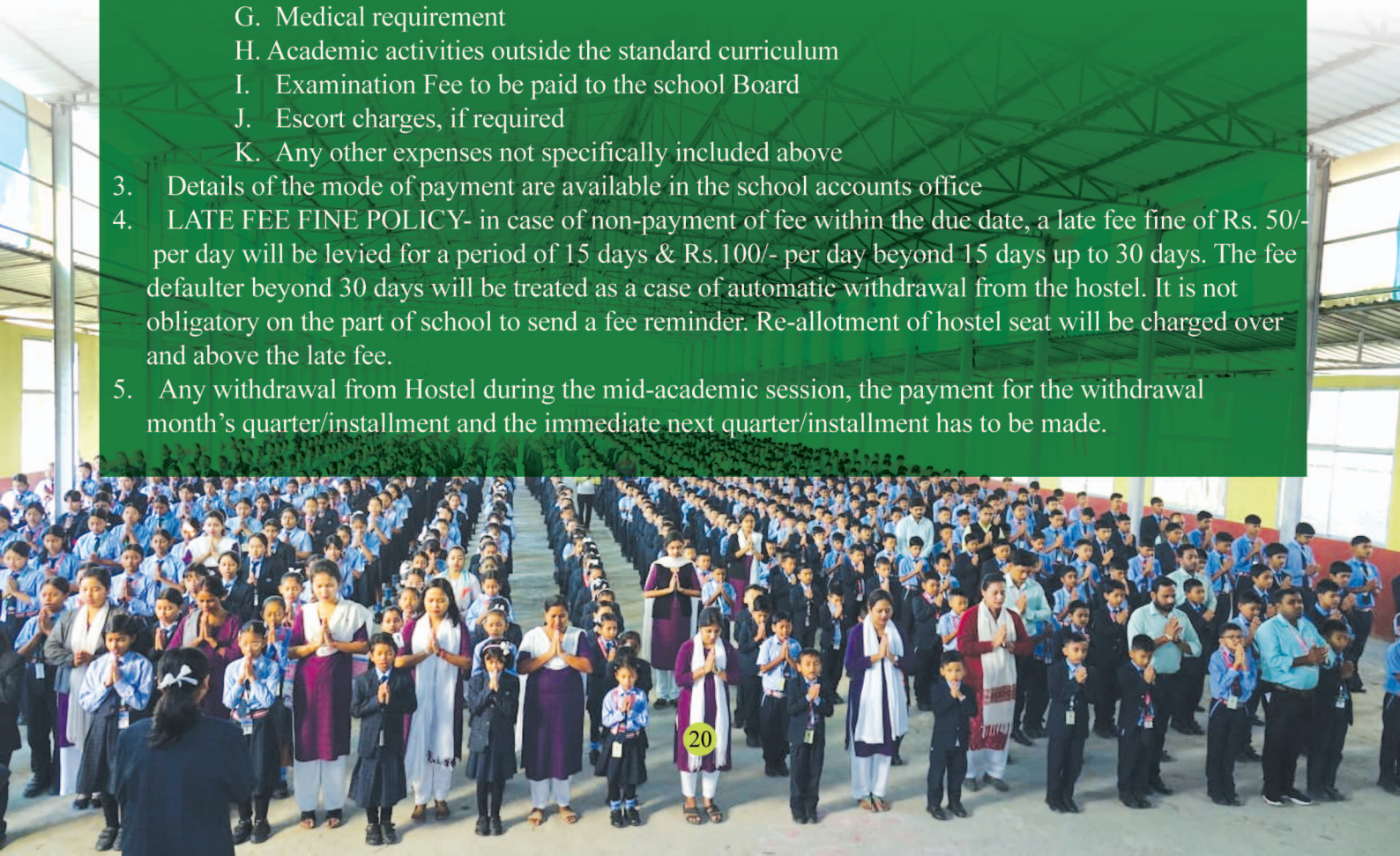


Important Notes for day hostellers for fee payment:

1. School fee will have to be paid quarterly, by the 15th of the 1st month of each Qtr. i.e 15th April, 15th July, 15th October & 15th January respectively. Fees once paid are not refundable or transferable.
2. 5% discount will be given on the total fee deposited in advance for the entire academic year. (Before 15th April)
3. Transport facility, if required, will be charged as per requirement of the 3rd party.
4. Details about Mode of Payment are available in the school accounts office.
5. Once the student has been accepted for admission, all payments are to be made to confirm the admission
6. LATE FEE FINE POLICY- In case of non-payment of fee within the due date, a late fee fine of Rs. 50/- per day will be levied for a period of 15 days & Rs. 100/- per day beyond 15 days up to 30 days. The fee defaulter beyond 30 days will be treated as a case of automatic withdrawal and the name of the students will be struck off the rolls. It is not obligatory on the part of the school to send a fee reminder. Re-admission fee will be charged over and above the late fee (if re-admission is granted).

Important Notes for hostellers for fee payment:

1. Hostel fee will have to be paid in four installment i.e. before 15th of April, July, October and January respectively. Fees once paid are not refundable or transferable.
2. Student's Personal Imprest Account for the hosteller's personal expenses as per list given below. A minimum balance of Rs. 3000/- & 4000/-, as the case may be, must be maintained at any given time during the year. Imprest deposit must be replenished as and when demanded by the school.
 - A. Uniform
 - B. Stationery & Text Books
 - C. Blankets
 - D. Educational Tour
 - E. Personal requirements viz. toiletries, haircut
 - F. Sports Kit
 - G. Medical requirement
 - H. Academic activities outside the standard curriculum
 - I. Examination Fee to be paid to the school Board
 - J. Escort charges, if required
 - K. Any other expenses not specifically included above
3. Details of the mode of payment are available in the school accounts office
4. LATE FEE FINE POLICY- in case of non-payment of fee within the due date, a late fee fine of Rs. 50/- per day will be levied for a period of 15 days & Rs.100/- per day beyond 15 days up to 30 days. The fee defaulter beyond 30 days will be treated as a case of automatic withdrawal from the hostel. It is not obligatory on the part of school to send a fee reminder. Re-allotment of hostel seat will be charged over and above the late fee.
5. Any withdrawal from Hostel during the mid-academic session, the payment for the withdrawal month's quarter/installment and the immediate next quarter/installment has to be made.
